- 9) I understand that a failure to appear or termination of the remote appearance may result in the issuance of a warrant, a requirement that I appear in court, in person and/or a continuance or the court hearing.
- 10) I understand the court may decide at any time to require a personal appearance and continue the hearing. I understand that except as provided in California Rules of Court, Rule 1.150, court proceedings shall not be photographed, recorded, broadcast, or live-streamed. Violators may be cited for contempt of court, or monetary sanctions may be imposed.
